

Roosevelt Scout Reservation Honor Troop Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize those troops which conduct an excellent troop camping experience and program during their stay at Roosevelt Scout Reservation. The units will be recognized during the closing campfire on Friday evening.

The Roosevelt Scout Reservation Honor Troop Award can be earned by successfully completing 11 out of the 16 requirements listed below. Once completed, the troop must hand in this form to either McKeever Lodge or to the Camp Commissioner by noon on Friday.

| 8. | Complete the Camp Evaluation Form and turn into McKeever Lodge by Friday at Noon. | Camp Director | |
| 9. | Arrive on-time for ALL morning and evening flag ceremonies. | Program Director | |
| 10. | Complete an Approved environmental conversation project in camp. Talk to Nature Director for ideas. *Note: This does not include using the Monday Night Conservation used for MB program.* | Nature Director | |
| 11. | Have 25% of your Scouts either earn the Knify Knotter Award OR the Great Leaf-Off Award. | Scoutmaster | |
| 12. | Cook a meal In-site and host a staff member as a guest. | Invited Staff Member | |
| 13. | Have your ENTIRE wear their COMPLETE Field Uniform during every evening retreat as well as BOTH campfires. | Scoutmaster | |
| 14. | Have a well-informed Troop Bulletin Board and include the following information posted by Monday morning: Rosters (Troop, Waiter Duty, Latrine and Camp Cleaning, Etc.) Bunk Assignments Fire-Guard packet Any other information needed to be posted from the troop | Camp Commissioner | |
| 15. | Participate in a Troop-planned activity and invite another troop. | Invited Senior Patrol Leader | |
